Emergency Financial Assistance

Each day can bring new challenges and experiences to the social work staff at the Children's Blood & Cancer Center. The CBCC social work team steps into the lives of our patients on a daily basis—surrounded by challenges—and helps families discover their own strength. Superhero Kids emergency financial aid support is vital for them to do their jobs well.

A 17-year-old CBCC teen patient passed away recently, and our social work team came up with a creative wayto give him a final memory in the comfort of his own home, surrounded by the love of his family. At the time he was placed in hospice care, he was sharing a room with his two younger siblings. His family moved into a three bedroom rental to give him his own room and personal space to spend his final days. The room had a hospital bed, a television set and a few hanging pieces of clothing.

Utilizing the Superhero Kids fund, the social work team decorated his room with canvas pictures, bedding, a red recliner, bath towels, a shower curtain and bath mats. His room and bathroom looked great! They collaborated with the Sweet Dreams Foundation and Home Depot to add additional fixtures and items to transform his room into a peaceful environment filled with his favorite colors and items.
